Jude 24-25 (NKJV) Glory to God

24 Now to Him who is able to keep you[a] from stumbling,

And to present you faultless

Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy,

25 To God our Savior,[b]

Who alone is wise,[c]

Be glory and majesty,

Dominion and power,[d]

Both now and forever.

Jude 17-23 (NKJV)

17 But you, beloved, remember the words which were spoken before by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ: **18** how they told you that there would be mockers in the last time who would walk according to their own ungodly lusts. **19** These are sensual persons, who cause divisions, not having the Spirit. Maintain Your Life with God **20** But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, **21** keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. **22** And on some have compassion, making a distinction;[a] **23** but others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire,[b] hating even the garment defiled by the flesh.
